

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

A contractor for the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet is cutting timber along the new route for US 68/KY 80 through the Land Between The Lakes.

During the clearing of right of way for the new four-lane highway trucks will be entering and exiting the existing roadway. Flaggers are controlling traffic at various points through the construction zone. The movement of trucks and other equipment on and off the highway in the work zone may create some minor delays.

Trees within the right of way have been purchased from the U.S. Forest Service which operates LBL. All trees along the 8-mile route that have commercial value will be salvaged for timber use.

The burning of tree tops and other debris along the route may create smoke that could limit visibility at times. Motorists should use appropriate caution when smoke is present.

Access to LBL attractions will be maintained throughout the construction work.

Rogers Group, Inc. leads the construction team on the \$48.4 million design-build project that includes QK4, Haydon Brothers Contracting, and Scott & Murphy, Inc. The expected completion date is November 2009.
